Objectives: The Sub-Fund promotes environmental or social characteristics and is considered a financial product according to Article 8 (1) SFDR and while it does not have as its objective a sustainable investment, it will have a proportion of its portfolio invested in sustainable investments. The Sub-Fund is mainly investing in cleantech companies. The Sub-Fund focuses on investing in companies with environmental characteristics that provide products and services related to (without being exhaustive): Climate change mitigation, such as renewable energy, energy efficiency, clean transport; Climate change adaptation, such as draught and flood protection, climate-resilient infrastructure, climate adaptation services; Sustainable use and protection of water and marine resources, such as water management, water-saving technologies, protection and restoration of marine ecosystems; Transition to a circular economy, such as waste management, recycling, durable and recyclable products, circular design and packaging; Pollution prevention and control, such as reducing air, water and soil pollution; Protection and restoration of biodiversity and ecosystems, such as sustainable agriculture and aquaculture. Additionally, the Sub-Fund is investing in companies with social characteristics that provide products and services that ensure healthy lives and promote well-being, in areas such as (without being exhaustive): healthy food, healthcare, safety, leisure and education. Performance-Scenarios:
